ELECTRONIC VISITOR SCREENING SYSTEM (EVSS) - PHASE II

SCOPE OF WORK: Provide all labor, materials, equipment, installation and services for electronic visitor screening systems (EVSS) and cameras to selected CDC and Head Start sites, District-wide.

ESTIMATED PROJECT COST: \$547,964

PROJECT DURATION: 365 (THREE HUNDRED SIXTY FIVE) consecutive calendar days.

LICENSE REQUIREMENTS: At the time bids are submitted, each bidder shall possess a valid **Class C-7 and/or C-10 license** and must maintain the license throughout the duration of the project. All work performed for this project must be done by properly licensed and/or certified contractors/subcontractors.

PREQUALIFICATION:

To bid on this Project, the Bidder is required to have been prequalified by the District. In addition, if the Project has electrical, mechanical, or plumbing components that will be performed by subcontractors performing under the following license classification(s), then each of those subcontractors that intend to bid as a first-tier subcontractor to a general contractor (prime contractor) are required to have been prequalified by the District: C-4, C-7, C-10, C-16, C-20, C-34, C-36, C-38, C-42, C-43, and/or C-46.

Contractors and Subcontractors required to be prequalified or needing to renew their prequalification status must submit a complete prequalification questionnaire packet through www.QualityBidders.com no later than ten (10) business days prior to the Bid Opening.

It is the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure all subcontractors, listed in their bid, are prequalified prior to the bid opening. If it is found that a Contractor has listed a Subcontractor in their bid that UTILIZES any of the licenses required to be prequalified and is NOT prequalified with the District for five (5) business days prior to the bid opening, the Contractor's bid will be rejected and deemed non-responsive.

All current health & safety protocols shall be followed. Only groups of ten (10) bidders at a time will be allowed to walk the project. Bidders shall not visit the project site without an authorized District Representative present.



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REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION (RFIs): All questions are to be submitted through PlanetBids only. Any RFI submitted in any other format or in any other method shall go unanswered.

BID SUBMISSIONS: Bids are to be submitted and uploaded electronically via the District's [Online Vendor Portal](#) on PlanetBids **on or before 2:00 PM on August 6th, 2021**. Bidder assumes full and sole responsibility for timely receipt of its Bid and any other documents required to be submitted with the Bid, by the District at the Online Vendor Portal.

AWARD: This contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder.

DISTRICT ALLOWANCE: A District allowance of **\$54,796** for unforeseen circumstances, will be added to the awarded contract. See bid form for more information.

BID SECURITY: A Bid Security of 10% of total bid amount is required to be submitted with bid form. Successful Bidder will be required to furnish 100% Payment and Performance Bonds. The successful Bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract, in accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.

PREVAILING WAGES: The successful Bidder and its subcontractors shall pay all workers on the Project not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Bidders and Bidders' subcontractors shall comply with the registration and qualification requirements pursuant to sections 1725.5 and 1771.1 of the California Labor Code.
