SCOPE OF WORK: Provide all labor, materials, and equipment outside of the labor, materials, and equipment covered through the OFOI CMAS, for the replacement of existing track & field with a new synthetic running track and artificial turf. Sports field to meet CIF regulation. Work includes new long jump, triple jump, high jump, pole vault, shotput and ADA improvements, per bid plans and specifications.

ESTIMATED PROJECT COST: \$3 - \$3.5 million

PROJECT DURATION: 182 consecutive calendar days.

LICENSE REQUIREMENTS: At the time bids are submitted, each bidder shall possess a valid **Class B license** and must maintain the license throughout the duration of the project.

PREQUALIFICATION: Bidders and subcontractors with the following license classifications must be prequalified by the District: (1) Bidders with an A or a B license and (2) Bidders and subcontractors with a C-4, C-7, C-10, C-16, C-20, C-34, C-36, C-38, C-42, C-43, and/or C-46 license(s) that intend to bid as a prime contractor or as a first-tier subcontractor to a prime contractor that is bidding directly to the District. Contractors and Subcontractors required to be prequalified or needing to renew their prequalification status must submit a complete prequalification questionnaire packet through www.QualityBidders.com no later than ten (10) business days prior to the bid submission date noted below. It is the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure all subcontractors, listed in their bid, are prequalified prior to the bid date. If it is found that a Contractor has listed a Subcontractor in their bid that UTILIZES any of the licenses required to be prequalified and is NOT prequalified with the District for five (5) business days prior to the bid date, the Contractor's bid will be rejected and deemed non-responsive.

SITE VISIT/JOB WALK: A **non-mandatory** visit to the project site is scheduled for **December 29, 2020 at 10:00am** located at the address above. To request attendance, please send an email to Contracts@LBSchools.net. A confirmation email will be sent. No more than one (1) person per firm will be allowed to attend due to current restrictions. All current health & safety protocols shall be followed. Only groups of ten (10) bidders at a time will be allowed to walk the project. Bidders shall not visit the project site without an authorized District Representative present.

REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION (RFIs): All questions are to be submitted through PlanetBids only. Any RFI submitted in any other format or in any other method shall go unanswered.

BID SUBMISSIONS: Bids are to be submitted and uploaded electronically via the District's [Online Vendor Portal](#) on PlanetBids **on or before 2:00 PM on January 19, 2021**. Bidder assumes full and sole responsibility for timely receipt of its Bid and any other documents required to be submitted with the Bid, by the District at the Online Vendor Portal.

AWARD: This contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder.

DISTRICT ALLOWANCE: A District allowance of **\$350,000** for unforeseen circumstances, will be added to the awarded contract. See bid form for more information.



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BID SECURITY: A Bid Security of 10% of total bid amount is required to be submitted with bid form. Successful Bidder will be required to furnish 100% Payment and Performance Bonds. The successful Bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract, in accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.

PREVAILING WAGES: The successful Bidder and its subcontractors shall pay all workers on the Project not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Bidders and Bidders' subcontractors shall comply with the registration and qualification requirements pursuant to sections 1725.5 and 1771.1 of the California Labor Code.
